GUIDE TO SEASONAL PROGRAMS: BRIGHTON 2017-2018

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Our six-week program is dedicated to teaching the fundamental skills of skiing or snowboarding while instilling a passion for the mountain environment for all levels of participants. Skiing and riding with the same coach* each week helps participants to gain a level of comfort, familiarity, and consistency; factors that are all key to an enjoyable and successful learning experience. The first day will be dedicated to evaluation and forming groups based on age and ability level. Students may ski or ride with a friend of the same discipline, and will be placed into the lower group if their abilities differ.

*While we strive to keep groups with the same coach each week, if a child is progressing at a drastically different rate than the rest of their group they may be moved into another. There may be some instances of coaches missing work for illness or injury in which case a substitute coach would take over for that day or the class may combine with another.

Times and Lessons:

We will have lesson options for all ability levels in both the morning and the afternoon. Morning lessons meet at **9:45am** for lessons from **10:00-12:00pm**. Afternoon lessons meet at **12:45pm** for lessons from **1:00-3:00pm**.

We have a small number of beginner and novice lessons available for participants who wish to take a full-day lesson. Spaces are limited, and a minimum number of participants is required in each level. These lessons meet at 9:45am and end at 3:00pm with an unsupervised hour break for lunch; parents and coaches will decide on a meeting time for lunch at drop-off each day.

Please remember all lessons <u>do not</u> include rental equipment, lunch, or snacks. If students are renting equipment on-mountain they must reserve ahead of time and pick up their rental gear before their lesson. We recommend giving that process at least 45 minutes.

Meeting Place & Pick-up:

Entry to the Seasonal Programs corral is located next to the large trail map in the base area. Coaches will be available fifteen minutes before and after the on-snow portion of the lesson. Look for our "Multi-week lessons meet here" sign.

Late Arrivals/Absences:

To ensure each student is getting the most out of each lesson and to maximize teaching time, groups will leave the corral promptly at the lesson start time (10:00am/1:00pm). If a class is missing students, the rest of the group will take a warm-up lap before returning to the corral to pick up any latecomers. Students who arrive after this point may not be able to re-join their group.

Classes missed due to absence or tardiness cannot be made-up or refunded. If the highway and/or resort closes we will discuss reschedule options with the group coordinator.

ADDITIONAL OPTIONS:

Kids Club: 3-6 year old skiers or snowboarders

To take advantage of the support and infrastructure of our Youth Programs facility, Brighton families are eligible for a **10% discount** on Kid's Club single day and 3-Pack lesson packages only if purchasing through the Stevens Pass Brighton webpage **from November 1st onwards**. Our facility offers a supportive and fun experience for your little ones with both indoor and outdoor activities as well as a restroom and plenty of hot cocoa! Because preschool-aged kids learn at such different rates, there is no guarantee of having the same coach or group each visit.

Drop your child off and we'll take care of the rest!

- We will get them outfitted with rental gear and a lift ticket
- Kids will have an opportunity to use restroom before hitting the slopes
- We'll make sure they are ready to hit the slopes

Please note that by participating in Kids Club you understand:

- Kids must be checked-in **no later than 9:15am** for morning lessons (12:15 for afternoon lessons) for equipment fitting and to allow time to meet their coach and classmates for the day. You may check your child in as early as 8:00am.
- Kids will be placed in groups based on ability level each day so reservations should be made in advance of each visit
- Standard Kids Club rescheduling/cancellation policies apply to purchases and reservations made
- 3-Packs are non-transferable and non-refundable, daily reservations should still be made as visits are not restricted to the six predefined dates of the regular Brighton program (above) and may be used any day of the season.
- All Kid's Club participants must have passed their third birthday, be fully and independently potty trained, cold free, and excited to learn to ski or snowboard.
- Full day lessons are not available to 3 or 4 year olds
